## The Red-Rose city of Petra [Full Day visit]

This is an enchanting tour of Jordan's Red Rose city of Petra.

To reach the city, the visitors walk on foot, on horseback [for short distance] through the awesome Siq, an immense crack in the Nubian sandstone. Near the end of the passage, Petra's most impressive monument, Al Khazneh [The Treasury] appears. It is by far, one of the most elegant remains of antiquity, carved out of the solid rock from the mountain. Beyond al Khazneh, visitors can continue on foot to the Deir [Monastery] and the Roman-style Palace Tomb.



### Tour program:

Pick-up time: 08:00 AM – Hotel Lobby

08:00 - 11:30 hrs – Transfer to Petra via Desert Highway.

11:30 – 16:00 hrs – Petra site Visit including a short horse ride, walk through the 2 km Siq, stop in front of the Treasury, the most famous monument in Petra, for snap shots, visit Roman Amphitheater & the Monastery after climbing the 800 steps.

16:00 hrs - Transfer back to hotel in Amman via Desert Highway.

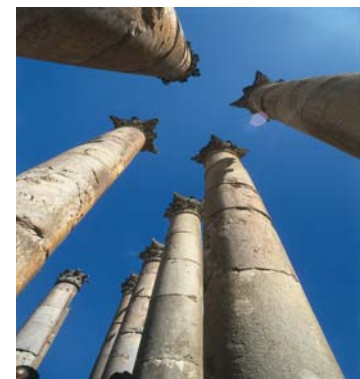
## Excursion to Jerash [Half Day]

Over one hour drive from the Dead Sea, towards north, you will visit the Graeco-Roman City of Jerash [ancient Gerasa], close second to Petra on the list of favorite destinations in Jordan.

Boasting an unbroken chain of human occupation dating back more than 6,500 years and hidden for centuries in sand before being excavated and restored over the past 70 years, Jerash is a fine example of the grand, formal and provincial Roman towns found throughout the Middle East.

You can walk beneath two imposing gates or down the "Street of Columns" north from the "Oval Plaza" while stepping over the tracks of chariot wheels still visible in the paving stones that will lead your way to impressive theaters, temples & churches.

You can also watch the unique live show of Roman Army chariots & gladiators. [Ticket not included in the price]

**Visit can be also organized in the afternoon.**

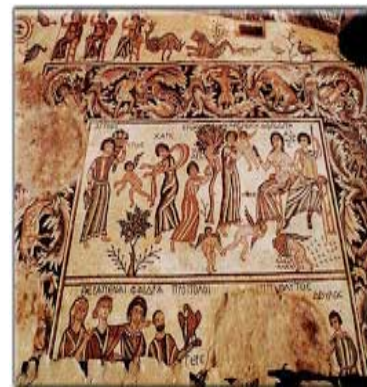
**Madaba & Mt. Nebo visit [Half Day]**

Afternoon departure towards Madaba & Mt. Nebo located 35 km from Amman.

Mount Nebo, the memorial of Moses and the presumed site of the prophet's death and burial place is one of the most revered places in Jordan.

From a platform in front of the church built by the early Christians in 393 AD, you will enjoy a breathtaking view across the Jordan Valley & the Dead Sea.

10 minutes drive from Mt. Nebo, you will visit Madaba, also known as the City of Mosaics". In St. George Church you will admire a wonderfully vivid, sixth century Byzantine mosaic map, showing Jerusalem and the Holy Land.



**Tour program:**

13:00 – 13:45 hrs – Transfer Amman – Madaba.  
14:00 – 14:45 hrs – visit St. George Church in Madaba & look for souvenirs in the nearby shops.  
14:45 – 15:00 hrs – Transfer Madaba – Mt. Nebo  
15:00 – 16:00 hrs – Mt. Nebo visit  
16:00 – 17:00 hrs – Transfer Mt. Nebo – hotel in Amman

**The Dead Sea & Baptism Site visit [Full Day]**

The Dead Sea is an attractive destination for visitors from around the world due to its unique water qualities, climate & historical legacy. This "Sea of Salt" sits amidst the sensational mountains of the Biblical Kingdoms of Moab, Ammon and Edom to the east, and the rolling hills of Jerusalem to the west. Enjoy a buoyant swim while reading a newspaper or just watch the thick, gleaming rocks like snow that gives the area a strange surreal sense as if it were in another world. One should always remember that this is the lowest point on Earth (400 Meters Below Sea Level) and a place that is believed to be the site of five biblical cities: Sodom, Gomorrah, Admah, Zebouin & Zoar.

Baptism site [Bethany beyond the Jordan River], is located less than 10 km from the Dead Sea & about 60 km from Amman. The large loop in the Jordan River, opposite Jericho has long been identified as the spot where John the Baptist baptized Jesus Christ. It is called al Maghtas in Arabic. This site and surrounding area were designated by the Vatican as a Millennium 2000 pilgrimage site and have quickly become the focal point for spiritual travelers from all around the world.

From the visitors centers you'll be transferred by minibus near the Jordan River where baptism spring & other significant remains of early Christian settlements have been discovered.

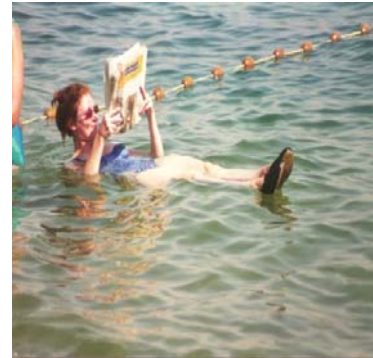
